

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

EACH OF THE FOLLOWING MUST BE DOWNLOADED AND MAILED OR HAND DELIVERED TO HAMPTON UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF PHARMACY, OFFICE OF ACADEMIC AND STUDENT AFFAIRS, KITTRELL HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA 23668 BY JANUARY 15. ALL CONTENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED AT THE SAME TIME.

_____ An **HU Undergraduate Application**
A **non-refundable application fee** of \$35.00 must be submitted.
(Please note: **SEND A MONEY ORDER OR CASHIER'S CHECK. PERSONAL CHECKS and CASH are NOT ACCEPTED**)

_____ A **School of Pharmacy Application**.
If a pharmacy school/college has been attended, a letter of recommendation from the Dean of the school/college of pharmacy indicating your status in that pharmacy program.

_____ **PCAT** (The Pharmacy College Admission Test) taken no later than **November** to meet the January 15 deadline.

_____ An **official transcript** from **ALL** colleges/universities ever attended. If you are enrolled in courses during the fall semester/quarter, you should submit a transcript to our office prior to the January 15 deadline for that term. We do not make exceptions for the late arrival of any transcripts. Official transcripts must be sent to applicant in a sealed envelope and same must be mailed to Hampton University School of Pharmacy by the deadline along with all other required admissions information.

_____ **Two (2) Letters of Recommendation** using the forms provided on our website. Letters received without the form will not be accepted. Recommendation forms must be mailed to applicant in a sealed envelope with recommender's name signed across the back. These forms are to be submitted with the rest of the admissions required information. Recommendations should be completed by a pharmacist or science/math professor.

_____ If not currently enrolled in school, a **Personal Growth Letter** indicating current activities.

Additional Information:

_____ **Spring transcript** if applicable is due by **May 31st**.

_____ **Summer transcript** if applicable is due the Friday before New Student Orientation (date will vary each year).

A minimum 2.75 GPA (based on 4.00 scale) is required for consideration with a "C" grade or better in all transferable coursework. Please be advised that the completion of the suggested prerequisite courses does not guarantee admission to the School of Pharmacy. Please be advised also that failure to accurately, completely and truthfully execute the application for admission or the omission of any information may result in the cancellation of admission and/or the dismissal from the School of Pharmacy.

An interview is required for admission. The most competitive applicants will be invited for an interview. Completion of an application and meeting requirements do not guarantee an interview or admission.

The School of Pharmacy has received Full Accreditation status by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE), the body that accredits Schools and Colleges of Pharmacy in the United States.
